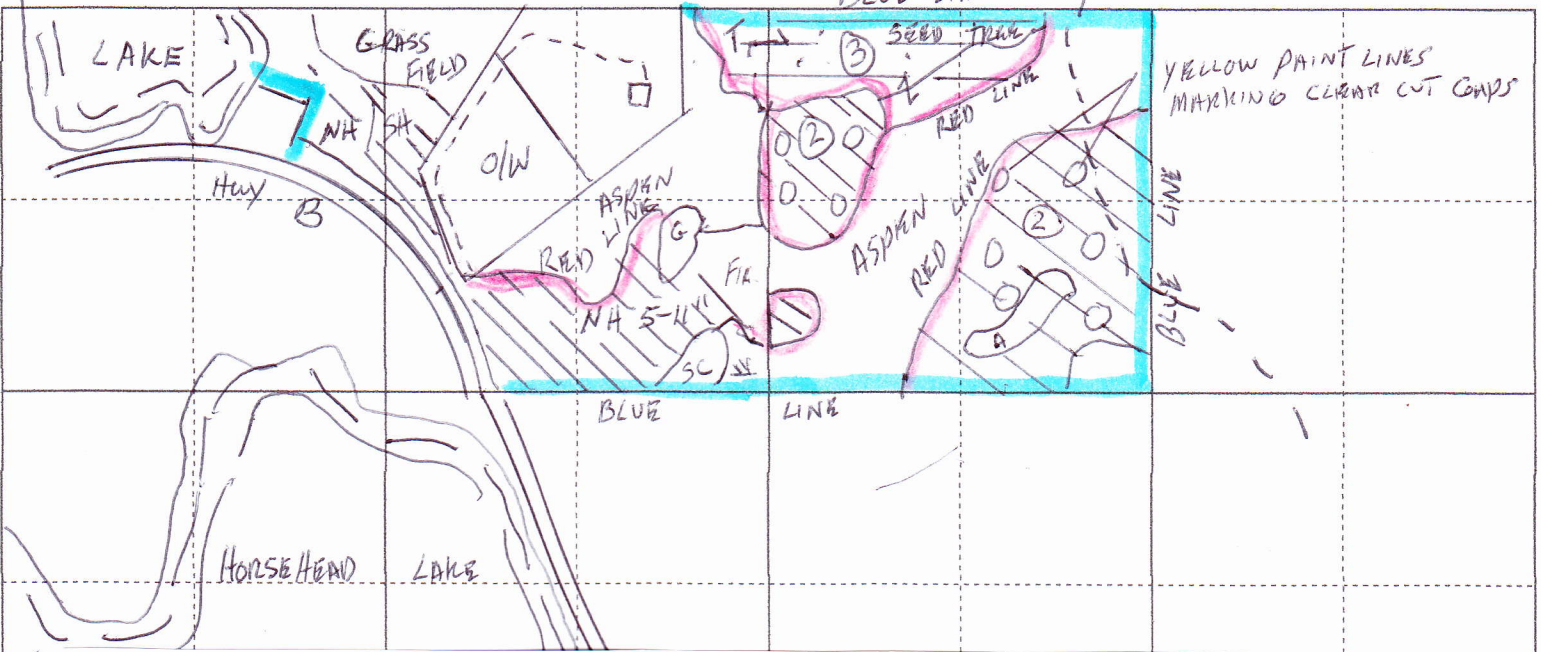

**CUTTING REQUIRMENTS**

Cut all trees marked with orange paint, including those trees marked less than 4" diameter in canopy gaps in this maple thinning/ red maple gap harvest and tamarack seed tree cut (leave all seed trees marked with green paint in stand 3). Also cut all aspen and balsam fir, inside red lines. In red maple stand 2, cut trees marked with orange paint plus all trees inside the 10, 1/3 acre gaps marked with yellow paint. To minimize damage to residual trees and advanced regeneration winter logging recommended, but parts could be cut in a dry summer. No cutting or skidding in April, May or June. Snowmobile trail will have to be kept cleared of slash so it can be used for recreation. "Sawlogs" have the following minimum specifications and include #3 logs: Minimum diameter small end, hardwoods 10.6 inches, length 8 feet; maximum scale deduction 50%. Utilize all pulpwood to a minimum 4-inch top diameter and all sawtimber to a 10-inch min top diameter. Boundaries are marked by blue paint, red paint and pink ribbon, no cutting or felling across cutting lines. All survey corners must be protected from logging damage. Good network of roads and trails and additional logging roads subject to advance approval by Forester and WI BMP's for water quality followed. The Rolling terrain includes some drainages and wet soils in tamarack bog. All payments will be based on Mill scale and scale slips sent to forester in timely manner.

**Bids must be a received on or before January 30th with a 10% bid deposit.** A 20% performance bond guarantee will be required at the time the contract is signed. Send to:
